



THE 2009 CIVIC SOCIETY AWARDS



THE AWARDS

- The Leicester Civic Society Awards recognise and celebrate architectural and urban design excellence in relation to the historic built environment.

GEOGRAPHICAL SCOPE

- The City of Leicester.

CATEGORIES

- There shall be two categories of award:

1. Excellence in the restoration - in whole or part - of a building or group of buildings constituting part of the recognised historic built environment of the City of Leicester. Such building or buildings must be on the Statutory List, Local Interest List or within a Conservation Area.

2. Excellence in new build complimenting the recognised historic built environment of the City of Leicester. That is, adjoining a listed building or local interest building where the new build enhances the setting of that building. Or inside or adjoining a conservation area where the new build contributes towards the character of that area.

COMPLETION DATE

- Projects must have been completed between 1st January and 31st December 2009.

JUDGING PROCESS

- The judging panel shall consist of members of the Executive Committee of Leicester Civic Society as at 13th February 2010, together with other society members at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- Panel members may nominate entries. However panel members having a personal or pecuniary interest in an entry must declare such interest and in so doing bar themselves from the judging process for that entry.
- The Panel may decide to make commendations to entries that it considers outstanding but which have failed to gain awards.
- Should the panel conclude that excellence has not been achieved in any one category they will decline to make an award for that category.

AWARDS CEREMONY

- The Awards will be made at a presentation ceremony and dinner to be held on Friday 9th April 2010 at The City Rooms, Hotel Street. Leicester. All those attending must conform to the deadlines and other booking conditions of the host venue.
- Two free invitations will be issued to each of the two winners and two to the guest of honour making the awards. A maximum of six. All others attending, including any guests of the winners, those awarded commendations and Civic Society members, must make full payment to the Society by the deadline stipulated.

HOW TO ENTER

- Anyone may nominate an entry by completing the form overleaf and submitting before Saturday 13th February 2010. Although you are welcome to do so, you do not need to provide plans or photographs. The judging panel will arrange for these if necessary.
